


Managerial Process Defined

- A sequence of steps by which people in an organization carry out a specific chunk of work.
- Can be tightly scripted and linear: product flow diagrams, supply chain steps, etc.
- Can be highly organic, loose, and non-iterative: startup product development.

Requirements for an Effective D-M Process

Managers must design a process that:

- Generates multiple alternatives up front;
- Stimulates constructive debate;
- Minimizes interpersonal conflict;
- Avoids coalitions;
