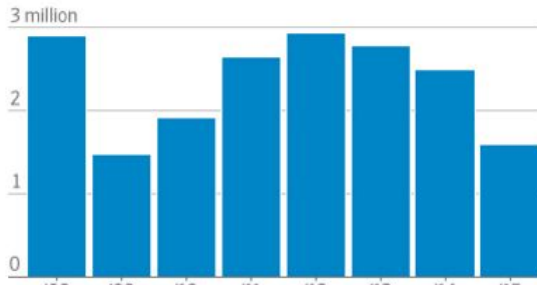

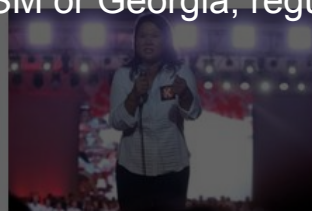

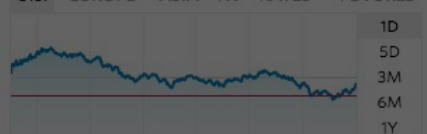


Peruvian Presidential Election Heads for Runoff

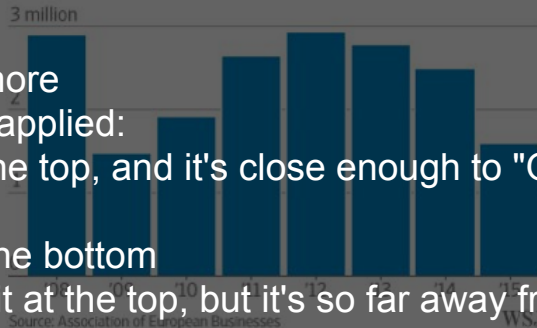

Total number of cars and light trucks sold in Russia

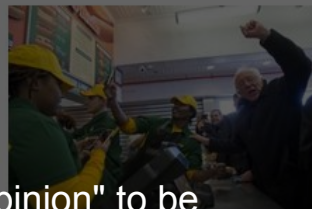
